Bra-Making 101: Let Jane help you fit and sew a professionally made bra that fits perfectly. On day 2, learn how to add designer details to your second bra. The cost includes kits for both bras. Sat & Sun, Sept. 19 & 20 or Nov 14 & 15; 9am-5pm \$220

Jeans: Sewing a pair of jeans is quite easy with the KwikSew pattern. The instructions are clear and the pattern fits well. Students should be able to wear their jeans home! Some pre-class work will be required. Mon Sept 14, 21, 28; 6:30-9:30pm \$90

Easy Sewing the Kwik-Sew Way: An exciting way to sew. A 6-lesson session for any sewer. The goal is to use the KwikSew pattern book and give students an increased confidence in sewing, while challenging and exploring creativity. 2. Sew a basic **Blouse** with collar and cuffs. Turn the shirt into a dress or coat and learn more about personal design changes. Mon Jan 11, 18, 25, 1, 8; 6:30-9:30pm \$180
3. **Pants and Skirts** are wardrobe basics. Make more than one and learn how to fit the crotch and prevent uneven skirt hems. Mon Feb 22, Mar 1, 8, 15, 22m 28; 6:30-9:30pm \$180

Serger:

Beginner Serger: This class is for those who know very little about their sergers. Paced so that you can learn to use your serger properly and with confidence, the instructor will teach you many time saving tips and tricks to enable you to get the most out of your serger. You will make three practical projects to show off your new skills as well making samples for a sample book. \$120 Fri Sept 11, 18, Oct 2; 12:30-3:30pm

Serger Basics: A shortened version of our beginner serger class. In three hours students will learn how to thread their machine, and learn the full variety of stitches a serger can do. Wed, Oct 27; 6:30-9:30pm \$50
