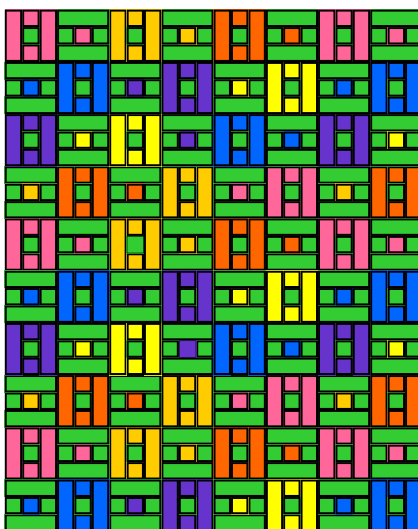


Stash Busters

Garden Path

This simple-to-stitch quilt is made from a collection of Fat Quarters. The pattern calls for greens and floral prints. So, dig out those lovely spring time prints and a variety of tone-on-tone greens and solids.



This quilt is probably one of the easiest of the series to make. We have chosen to set in in the spring....floral prints and green alternating. The blocks measure 6" finished. This is a project that can continue to grow after the Stash Buster Event.

The finished quilt top will measure 48" x 60" and you will need to make a total of 80 blocks.

The pattern for a lap size quilt requires a total of 12 Fat Quarters of Fabric. Border is extra. This quilt is scrappy, so you will need to bring an assortment of Fat Quarters in the following colours.

- 6 Fat Quarters in floral prints. The pieces will be 2" wide, so when choosing which FQ to bring, make sure you can see a variety of floral colours in each 2" section. Try not to choose too many with a lot of green.
- 6 Fat Quarters in green prints and solids. When you look at a garden the greens will range from a very light, yellow green to a very dark (almost blue) green. Choose solids and tone-on-tone prints for the greatest contrast.

Don't forget to bring your sewing machine, rotary cutting tools, basic sewing supplies including fabric marking pencil, 12" ruler, thread and a coffee cup,
