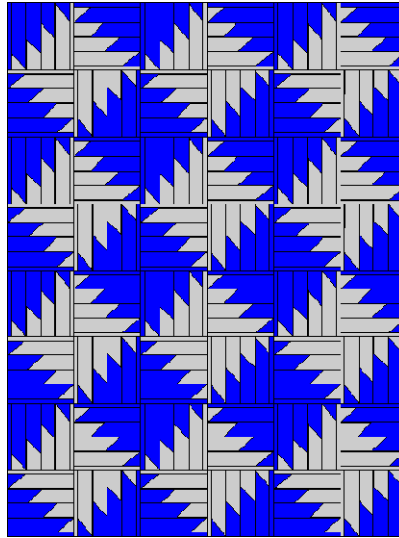


Stash Busters

Winter Ice

A variation on the Delectable Mountains block. This quilt is made with a variety of whites and very light blues and dark blues. Think of the very white "ice crystals" shining on a cold winter night.

There are a number of ways to arrange the blocks. We are planning to arrange the blocks as in the illustrations below. The blocks measure $7\frac{1}{2}$ " finished. The pattern requires 4 blocks be sewn together to create the light "ice crystals" in the dark sky.



The finished quilt top will measure 45 x 60" and you will need to make a total of 48 blocks.

The pattern for a lap size quilt requires a total of 1.5 meters each of a light and a dark fabric. Border is extra. This quilt is scrappy, so you will need to bring 6 strips of fabric measuring 0.25 meters or 9" wide of both the light and dark fabrics.

- Light: white (no cream or off white), white tone on tone, silver, very light blue.
- Dark: navy, very dark blue or grey

So, start stash busting and collecting these fabrics for the end of January.

Don't forget to bring your sewing machine, rotary cutting tools, basic sewing supplies including fabric marking pencil, 12" ruler and thread, a coffee cup,
