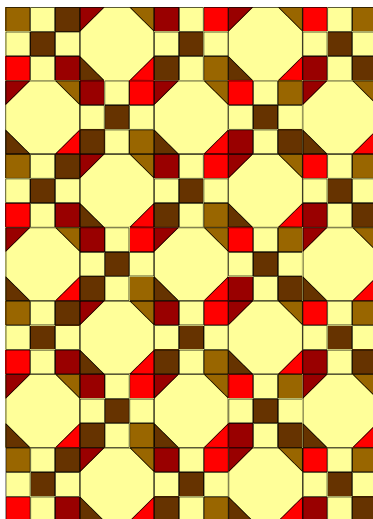




Chocolate Delight

What could be nicer than warming up with a box of delicious chocolates? There is lovely white chocolate, milk chocolate and my favorite the rich, dark chocolate....Add some lovely creamy filling and you have a warm and cuddly quilt.



Snowball blocks and 9-patch blocks make this a simple to piece project. Rather than a traditional Red and White for February, we thought the browns, reds and off-whites of a box of Chocolates would be appropriate.

The finished quilt top will measure 45" x 63" and you will need to make a total of 17 snowball blocks and 18 9-Patch blocks.

The pattern for a lap size quilt requires a total of 15 Fat Quarters of fabric. Border is extra. This quilt is scrappy, so you will need to bring an assortment of Fat Quarters in the following colours.

- 9 Fat Quarters in light creams, browns, pinks. Think of the inside of cream filled chocolates!
- 6 Fat Quarters in dark browns, reds, burgundies. Think of the outsides of those lovely rich decadent treats!

Don't forget to bring your sewing machine, rotary cutting tools, basic sewing supplies including fabric marking pencil, 12" ruler, thread and a coffee cup.
