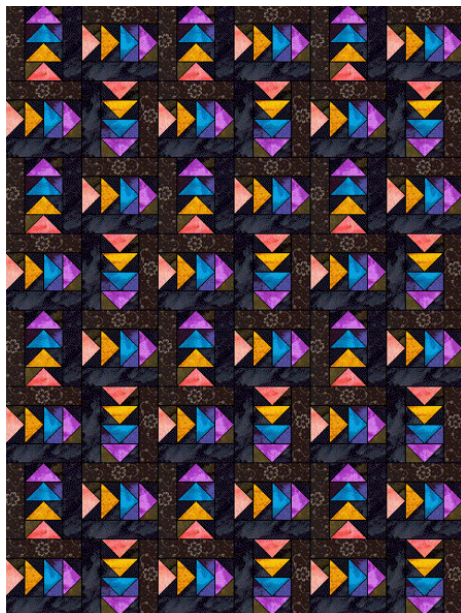


Stash Busters

Flying High

This lovely quilt is made with no-waste flying geese blocks. Imagine butterflies and brightly coloured birds flitting around on a warm spring evening. This is a perfect project for those lovely bright batiks we have been collecting. The brighter, the better. They will contrast beautifully with a very dark background. Use black solid, tone-on-tone or very dark background fabrics.



The finished quilt top will measure 48" x 64" and you will need to make a total of 48 blocks.

The pattern for a lap size quilt requires a total of 0.85 meters of geese fabrics and 2.5 meter background fabric. Border is extra.

- Geese Fabrics - 6 strips 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide. Chose your brightest (and loudest) batik fabrics for the best results.
- Background Fabrics - 5 strips 0.5 meters wide. Chose black, black tone-on-tone prints, very dark solids and tone-on-tones.

Don't forget to bring your sewing machine, rotary cutting tools, basic sewing supplies including fabric marking pencil, 12" ruler, thread and a coffee cup,
